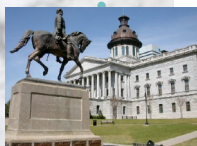

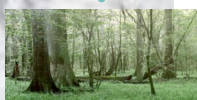


Horacio Sanchez Guest Speaker

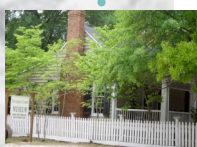


Susan Kovalik Featured Speaker

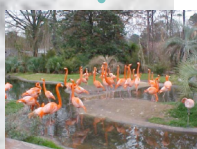
